Cemetery Mowing

It is important to use great care when mowing in the Town's historic cemeteries. These sites are both historical and sacred to those residents with relatives and ancestors buried there. Operators should move slowly when mowing and avoid bumping into or scraping gravestones. Low-lying stones and footstones should not be driven over as this scrapes the tops of the stones. Do not move broken gravestones as this makes it difficult for them to be properly identified, repaired, and replaced. Do not touch gravestones with trimmers as they leave a line at the base of the stone. Weeds and unsightly brush may be removed but avoid anything that looks like a memorial plant. Please report any unusual activity that you may discover when conducting the mowing services to Walter Adametz, Highway Foreman.
