The Town of Killingworth will receive sealed bids for EXTENSION OF ACCESSIBLE TRAILS AT IRENE SHELDON MEMORIAL PARK as set forth in drawings and specifications prepared by Nemergut Consulting, and Glenn A. Johnson, P.E., 20 Alders Bridge Road, Killingworth, CT 06419 **until November 28, 2016 by 3:00 p.m.** Bids will be opened in public and read aloud that evening at a Board of Selectmen's meeting at 7:00 p.m. at the Killingworth Town Hall.

The work shall include but is not limited to:

- Installation and Maintenance of Sediment and Erosion Controls
- Clearing and Grubbing
- General Earthwork
- Topsoil removal, screening and re-application
- Installation of approximately 860 linear feet of 5' wide Paved Walkways
- Site Restoration
