## New Rules, New Hours

### During COVID-19 Emergency

#### NEW RULES

In order to keep the Transfer Station open without risking the spread of the coronavirus, we will be operating with new rules, starting immediately:

- A limited number of vehicles will be allowed into the Transfer Station at a time.
- If a line of vehicles is waiting to enter, we will direct vehicles into the parking area by Rocco Reale field rather than letting traffic back up onto Route 81.
- While you are inside the Transfer Station, maintain at least a 6-foot distance between yourself and anyone else.

Please limit yourself to one trip to the Transfer Station per week. Do not go to the Transfer Station at all if you are sick. Your vehicle must display a red or green dump sticker, and the usual rules apply:

#### NEW HOURS

Tuesdays, 2 p.m. -7:00 p.m.	Household trash, recyclables <b>only</b>
Wednesdays, 3 p.m. – 6:00 p.m	Bulky Waste, Brush, Metals <b>only</b>
Thursdays, 2 p.m. -7:00 p.m.	Household trash, recyclables <b>only</b>
Saturdays, 8 a.m.- 2:00 p.m.	Household trash, recyclables <b>only</b>

**Household trash and recyclables** only during regular transfer station hours on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.

**Bulky waste and brush disposal:** Starting April 15, we will be accepting bulky waste, metals, and brush at the Transfer Station on **Wednesdays from 3:00 to 6:00 p.m.** No household trash or recycling will be accepted at that time.

- *Bulky waste* includes large items such as furniture, mattresses and box springs, large toys, and very small amounts of construction materials. *Brush* must not be more than 3" in diameter or 8' long.
- *Chipped brush for mulch* is available free to residents during these hours.

**Construction Debris:** Homeowners with more substantial amounts of construction debris must leave a message at Town Hall (860-663-1765) and obtain permission to deposit the debris at the Town Garage. Plan ahead; we may not be able to give you permission on the day you call.
