- 1. The meeting was called to order at 11:02 p.m.
- 2. Hutchins moved to approve the minutes of the September 3, 2021 meeting as submitted. The motion, seconded by Hogarty, carried. Voting in favor: Disbrow, Hutchins, Hogarty Opposed: none
- 3. Old business: pending application
 There was discussion about next steps for the pending application for 270 Green Hill Road. With
 the passage of the new regulation regarding the preservation of historic buildings and
 structures, it is hoped that the demolition permit will be rescinded. If not, the homeowners
 need to proceed with notifiying the public about pending demolition with a legal notice and
 signage. The homeowners will be sent a reminder letter next week.
- 4. New business: community outreach
 Suggestions were made regarding a campaign to promote the history of significant buildings in
 town, and to inform prospective buyers about the demolition delay ordinance. It was suggested
 that a note be added to the building files of each of the properties on the list of historically
 significant buildings compiled by RIverCog. Cross indexing of the book, currently in the vault,
 will begin next week. Future publicity projects were noted, and could be facilitated by
 collaboration with the Town Historian, the Historical Society and the Library.
