- 1. Acting First Selectman Annino called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
- RFP for Town Hall Roof Repair : A single sealed bid was opened from Lighthouse Construction in the amount of \$68,800.

All of the contract documents may be examined on-line at <u>www.townofkillingworth.com</u> under "RFP's and Bids", or at Killingworth Town Hall, 323 Route 81, Killingworth CT 06419 during the hours of 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM Monday through [Wednesday, Thursday 8:00AM – 7:00 PM Thurdsay and 8:00 AM – 12:00 PM Friday.] Printed copies can be made available for a non-refundable \$100 per bid package.

He then read the following from page 1 of the Invitation to Bid or the RFP For the Proposed Ballfield/Multipurpose field at Eric Auer Park:

OVERVIEW: This project includes the Construction of Baseball/Multi-Purpose Athletic Field in the Town of Killingworth, CT. The intent of the project is to construct a full-sized baseball diamond with the associated features (e.g. backstop, fencing, foul poles, flagpole, benches, etc.) as shown on the design drawings. This field will primarily support senior/advanced level baseball programs replacing the field formerly located at Irene Sheldon Park.

While Baseball is the base design and intended primary use of the field, its design also allows for other field programs such as lacrosse, soccer, field hockey, etc. This will be accomplished as is commonly designed, by allowing space for a multi-purpose field to be located across the outfield area of the baseball field. As such, fencing, benches and other field features are placed to support both functions.

Nothing in the construction of this project should be placed that would in any way restrict the use of this field as either a baseball field or multi-purpose field as described above.

Annino moved and to add the above narrative as an amendment to the motion above. The motion, seconded by Gorski, passed.
