 <u>DEMOCRAT TO VOTE IN THE DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY</u> and <u>YOU MUST BE A</u>

 <u>REGISTERED REPUBLICAN TO VOTE IN THE REPUBLICAN PRIMARY</u>.
- * THE DEADLINE FOR REGISTERED VOTERS TO TRANSFER FROM ONE POLITICAL PARTY TO ANOTHER TO VOTE IN THEIR APRIL 2nd PRIMARY HAS PASSED.
- *<u>IF YOU ARE AN UNAFFILIATED VOTER</u> (ie registered to vote but not enrolled with a political party) and wish to enroll in a party to vote in that party's April 2 primary:
 - you have until 12:00 noon on Monday, March 25 to file a voter registration application **in-person** with Registrars of Voters to enroll in that political party,
 - or mail-in a voter registration application that must be postmarked by <u>Friday</u>,
 March 15 to enroll in that political party,
 - or complete an on-line voter registration application to enroll in that political party at https://voterregistration.ct.gov/OLVR/welcome.do which must be received by Registrars of Voters by Friday, March 15.
- *<u>IF YOU ARE NOT ALREADY REGISTERED TO VOTE</u> and wish to vote in a primary, you have until <u>Friday</u>, <u>March 15</u>, <u>from 12:00 noon to 2:00 p.m.</u>, to file a voter registration application **in-person** with the Town Clerk or Registrars of Voters.
- *IF YOU DO NOT REGISTER TO VOTE BY MARCH 15, you may file a voter registration application during the early voting period above in-person with the Registrars of Voters or at the early voting location by noon the DAY BEFORE you want to vote to (1) enroll in a political party and (2) vote during early voting hours starting the next business day.
- * SAME DAY REGISTRATION AND VOTING IS NOT AVAILABLE ON APRIL 2ND.
