The Board of Selectmen held a Public Hearing to consider community projects seeking to qualify for the State of Connecticut tax credits from the 2024 Neighborhood Assistance Act Program.

Two applications were received from Pathfinders, Inc. and The Killingworth Library Association which were presented and discussed:

Pathfinders, Inc.'s Application #1: Deer Lake Energy Upgrades in the amount of \$24,000.

Pathfinders, Inc.'s Application #2: Deer Lake Day Camp Campership Program in the amount of \$20,000.

The Killingworth Library Association's Application #1: Build a permanent outdoor pavilion at the Library in the amount of \$23,000.

The Killingworth Library Association's Application #2: Build a permanent outdoor pavilion with solar panels on the roof in the amount of \$40,000.

Public inquiries were addressed and First Selectman Couture closed the Public Hearing at approximately 6:52 p.m.
