There will be a Special Meeting of the Board of Assessment Appeals (BAA) on **Monday**, **September 23**, **2024** from **6:00PM** – **7:30 PM** at Killingworth Town Hall for the sole purpose of hearing appeals related to assessments of **motor vehicles** on the **October 1**, **2023** Grand List (July, 2024 tax bills).

## How to schedule a hearing:

No advanced appointments; walk-in only. Appeals will be heard in order of arrival.

## What to bring to the hearing:

- 1) Your July 2024 tax bill;
- 2) The subject motor vehicle(s) for inspection by the members of the BAA;
- 3) If you cannot bring the vehicle, you will need to explain why it is unavailable and bring photos that clearly illustrate the condition and mileage of the vehicle;
- 4) Any other documentation to support your claim. Keep in mind: <u>you are appealing the value as</u> of October 1, 2023.

NOTE: Any photos or other evidence you bring to your hearing will become the property of the BAA. We encourage you to keep copies of any information you supply. Photocopies of your information will not be made at the time of your hearing.

## What happens next:

An 'Action Letter' with the Board's decision will be sent to you within one week of the decision.
