HEALTH AND SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 2:33 pm.

3. New Business

- a. Flu shot clinic-CRAHD will sponsor a flu shot clinic 10/17 from 2-6 pm for town hall employees, Fire Department & KAA members. CRAHD is also scheduling flu shot appointments for the general public on Wednesdays mid October through January at their office in Old Saybrook. Jim asked if Covid boosters will be available and Eric said it was not discussed at their meeting.
- b. Member concerns:

Jim mentioned that Fire Prevention Week is coming up next month, KVFD has a date set at KES (10/9) and they are still working on dates with the Middle and Intermediate Schools.

Elizabeth asked Jim if KVFD will give out smoke alarms again. Jim stated the program in the past was sponsored by the Red Cross. He hasn't heard if they will do that again in the future. The fire department will give smoke alarms out to residents if they have a failed one on their property.

Jim also asked what is being done about speeding in town. He knows it is an ongoing issue. Eric explained that troopers have been on Route 81 with radar guns and that Killingworth received a grant for extra troopers for a certain amount of time. Discussion continued about curtailing speeding around town.

4. Old Business

- a. Smoke alarms in the front of the building have been updated to have dedicated lines to ITS (previously town hall was tied in with the fire department.) Once that is finalized, we can have our fire drill. The back of the building still does not have smoke alarms.
