-Pickleball court construction status was discussed. A proposal from state approved Gordian was received. The proposal was over budget at \$300k. As project needs to be out to bid by 12/31/2024 to utilize ARPA funds, the BOS and BOF have agreed to pull ARPA funds from the

project and replace with funding through town capital fund. There was a discussion regarding the location of the courts being along Recycle Way, Glenn will work on a site plan.

-Sheldon Pavillon repair, there is a \$5k budget (ARPA) and a proposal from Liappes Home Improvement for \$4,750, replace boards, paint etc.

\*Chris made a motion to approve the proposal by Liappes Home Improvement to complete work on the Pavillon for \$4,750.00, Bill seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

## -Auer Park:

- Chris Plumb quote for flower beds

-Pavillon, Gordian quote, must be under contract by 12/31 for ARPA funds, was \$130k, 24'x24', not acceptable. The previous plan of separating aspects of the project is not workable currently due to staffing. There was a discussion regarding purchasing a structure from The Barnyard which would include construction. The site work would be extra. Jim will pursuit information and pricing from The Barnyard.

- The South Field Project, work is ongoing.
